...the LORD loves the gates of Zion more than all the dwelling places of Jacob. Glorious things of you are spoken, O city of God. Selah

C. Throw open God’s gates to the world!!!

A. God recognized His worship as diverse (4a)

Among those who know me I mention Rahab and Babylon; behold, Philistia and Tyre, with Cush-

1. Rahab/Egypt (Isaiah 30:7)
2. Babylon (Revelation 17:5)
3. Philistia (1 Samuel 17:4)
4. Tyre (Isaiah 23:1-9)
5. Cush
6. Zion

B. God’s worshipers all found life in the Lord regardless of location (4b-6)
