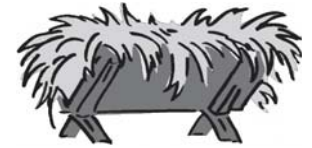

### God Sent His Son Born of a Woman Luke 2:1-20

#### Jesus born in the City of David vs. 1-7

- God sent his son into our world—\_\_\_\_\_
- God sent his son as a \_\_\_\_\_.

*But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons.* GALATIANS 4:4-5

#### Jesus' birth announced by angels vs. 8-20

- God sent his son for all \_\_\_\_\_.

*Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death—even death on a cross! Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord,* PHILIPPIANS 2:6-11

- God sent his son and the heavens rejoiced.

*Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to men on whom his favor rests.* LUKE 2:14

## How to Become a Christian

- Acknowledge that you (along with all people) have sinned and fallen short of God's standards. (ROMANS 3:23)
- Personally believe that Jesus Christ, who was God in human flesh, died for your sins on the cross and rose again. (I CORINTHIANS 15:3, 4)

You may express your belief through prayer, asking Jesus to come into your life, and receiving Him as God's gift to you.

(JOHN 1:12, ROMANS 6:23, REVELATION 3:20)
